Six Philadelphia Cultural Institutions Honor Hospital Workers with Free Admission Days

Museums offer free admission to healthcare heroes during National Hospital Week

Philadelphia, PA (April 30, 2021) — In honor of National Hospital Week, the Academy of Natural Sciences of Drexel University, the Barnes Foundation, Eastern State Penitentiary, the Franklin Institute, the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts (PAFA), and the Philadelphia Museum of Art jointly announce Free Admission Days for Hospital Workers.

The joint initiative honors the service and dedication of hospital workers throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. In appreciation of their critical, ongoing work to keep our communities safe and healthy, hospital workers and their families are invited to visit some of Philadelphia's top cultural institutions, free of charge. Redemption dates and booking instructions vary by institution; see below for details.

According to the American Hospital Association, National Hospital Week is “an opportunity to highlight our hospitals, health systems and health care workers and the innovative ways they are supporting the needs of their community members, especially during this pandemic.”

- **Eastern State Penitentiary–Wednesday, May 12**

 - The Barnes Foundation will be open exclusively for hospital workers on Thursday, May 13, noon to 7:00 p.m., and will not be otherwise open to the public.

- **Philadelphia Museum of Art and Rodin Museum–Friday, May 14–Monday, May 17**
